Lawyers: Mental Health and Addictions

Lawyers often struggle in silence with health and addiction issues. Incidence of depression, suicide and substance abuse are far higher among lawyers than the general population. The high-stress environment of law has led many to experience mental health issues. Tim Daley, Q.C. is one of these lawyers. By sharing his personal story of depression and recovery and through educating lawyers and regulators about mental health and addiction issues in the profession, he brings insight into the silent struggle and a way forward.

Tim is the immediate Past President of the Nova Scotia Barristers' Society and has served on various Society committees for over 20 years, including over 10 years as a member of the Complaints Investigation Committee. He currently serves as the Society's Special Advisor on Mental Health, a position created in 2013 to provide an opportunity for his work on lawyers' mental health challenges to continue. Tim has practiced law in a small town in Northern Nova Scotia for 22 years and focuses primarily on family law; he is also a part-time instructor at the Schulich School of Law, Dalhousie University.
