## Select Dinner The Philosophy & Ethics of Law

The Law Society is delighted to welcome Professor Eldon Soifer of the University of Regina to present this fascinating session. Eldon is the current Acting Head of the Department of Philosophy and Classics where he specialises in ethics, political philosophy, and philosophy of law. He also serves as an ethicist for the health region's ethics committee. Eldon holds a B.A. and an M.A. from the University of Toronto and a PhD from Oxford University. He has many publications, including a textbook he edited on contemporary moral issues entitled *Ethical Issues: Perspectives for Canadians*, a 4th Edition of which is expected later this year. He is also the proud father of two children, ages 14 and 12.

This informative and thought-provoking presentation will offer an overview of the relationship between Ethics and Law with some contemporary examples of how the concepts continue to resonate in the practice and discipline of law today. The presentation will offer some discussion around the issue of whether morality is inherently part of the law and the various schools of thought that flow from this philosophical question. Additionally, questions regarding whether or not the law should function to underscore or develop the value system of a society will be considered, along with whether the law should lead or respond to public opinion.
