## Spotlight: Court of King's Bench Registry Offices

The [Court of King's Bench](#), has broad jurisdiction on many legal matters. They play an important role in Saskatchewan: there are approximately 1400 statutes in Saskatchewan, and many have a right or remedy that can be brought to the Court of King's Bench.

There are ten Court of King's Bench [Judicial Centres](#) in the province. Each features a publicly accessible court registry office.

The court registry office is a **key access point** for people who interact with the Court of King's Bench.

These offices are responsible for processing, recording, and directing the flow of all documents in a court file, as well as recording all steps during a proceeding.

The public can **visit** a court registry office to **file or access** court documents.

Their staff can provide members of the public with general information about court process and direct people as to where to find legislation, legal information, self-help kits, forms and rules. The office staff cannot provide legal advice or indicate what should be included on a court form. Office staff can, however, provide general assistance on how to complete the court form.

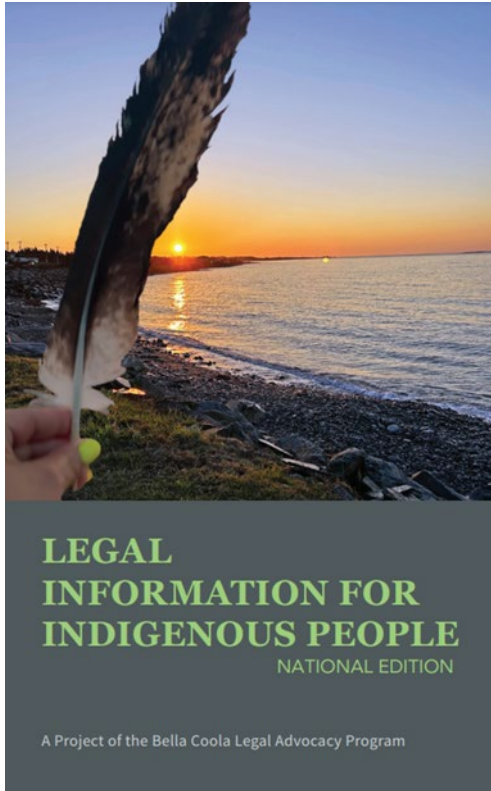
The Court of King's Bench provides legal information **resources for the public**.
